Xi pointed out that the Belt and Road Initiative is a public road open to all, not a private path owned by one single party. 3. National Economy Made a Good Start in the First Quarter

In the first quarter, the economy delivered a stable performance with a consolidated foundation and a good momentum of growth, production demand was expanded, market vitality was enhanced, employment and prices were stable and people's well-being was strongly guaranteed. The national economy made a good start. According to preliminary estimates, the gross domestic product (GDP) in the first quarter reached 24,931.0 billion yuan, up by 18.3 percent year on year, or up by 0.6 percent over that in the fourth quarter of 2020 and 10.3 percent over that in the first quarter of 2019, with an average two-year growth of 5.0 percent at comparable prices.
